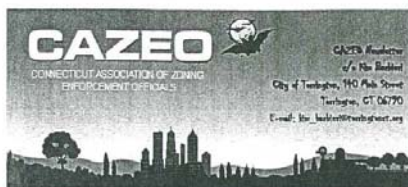
### TOPIC: COLLABORATION
